- 1. Meeting was called to order at 7:30 A.M. by Chairman Frank R. Rose.
- 2. He announced that this meeting was being recorded for the purpose of transcribing the minutes.

- 5. Office Update -
 - A. Commissioners reviewed and accepted the Districts' regular checks written June 30, 2023 to July 15, 2023. Motion was made by Commissioner Levingston, seconded by Chairman Rose. All voted Aye.
 - B. Commissioners reviewed and accepted the monthly financial report presented by Shanna Verret which showed an ending fund balance of \$1,610,241.37 a decrease of \$32,081.01 from last month. Motion was made by Commissioner Levingston and seconded by Chairman Rose. All vote Aye
 - C. Insurance summary from January to May 2023 was presented by Shanna Verret. The active employees have a profit of \$64,480.42 and retirees show a profit of \$7,431.66. Motion was made by Commissioner Levingston and seconded by Commissioner Rose to accept the insurance summary as presented. All vote AYE.
 - D. A review and discussion were held on the July 6, 2023 Preliminary Taxable Value that was presented in the amount of \$297,003,572.00. This value is a decrease of \$3,020,214.00 from the May 25th Value.
